2. Accident Waiver & Release of Liability

I HEREBY ASSUME ALL OF THE RISKS OF PARTICIPATING OR ATTENDING THIS ACTIVITY OR EVENT, namely the **A.C Perugia Talent Identification Camp July 2023**, including and not limited to, any risks that may arise from dangerous or defective equipment or property owned, maintained, or controlled by the **A.C Perugia Talent Identification Camp July 2023**, or because of their possible liability without fault. I warrant that I am in good health and proper physical condition to safely participate in this activity or event and have no known physical or mental conditions that would adversely affect my ability to safely participate in this activity or event.

5. Covid 19

A.C Perugia Talent Identification Camp July 2023 will be conducted in accordance with current Covid guidelines at the time of the trials. For 2023 trials, this currently means:

- Spectators are permitted at external venues, but numbers attending should be minimised as much as possible.
- No sharing of personal equipment – all students trialling will need their own equipment for the day.
- Minimise the use of change room facilities – students should come in their trial clothing.
- Social distancing guidelines, other than in game or training scenarios, should be adhered to at all times (1.5m)



6. Participant or Participants Parent / Caregiver Consent

- I have read the information issued and I hereby consent to myself or my child participating in this event.
- I understand that Australasian Soccer Academy will provide supervision at the event.
- I understand that transport to and from the event is my responsibility and that the arrival and departure arrangements are also the responsibility of the parent/caregiver unless otherwise specified.
- I have sighted the Australasian Soccer Academy Code of Conduct for participants, parents and spectators (refer to section 10 below) and agree that if I or my child seriously contravenes behavioural expectations, he/she may be immediately excluded from the team. I also understand that breaches of parents/spectators conduct may result in parents/spectators being asked to leave the venue.
- In the event of any accident or illness, I authorise the obtaining of, on my behalf, an ambulance and any such medical assistance that myself or child may require. I accept full responsibility for all expenses incurred.

Participants

5. Control your temper on and off the field – avoid criticism by word or gesture.
6. Encourage and support your teammates, applaud skilled performance and congratulate your opponents at the end of the game.



7. Be respectful of other's property. Stay in the designated areas, look after facilities and sporting equipment and remember to leave the area tidy and free of rubbish when you leave.

Parent / Caregiver & Spectators

1. Model the values of fairness, respect, honesty and cooperation.
2. Place the safety and welfare of all participants above all else.
3. Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour. Refrain from criticism and remember that positive comments are motivational.
4. Be courteous in your communication with instructors, event officials and sports administrators and follow their directions. Allow the event officials to conduct events without interference. If there is a disagreement, follow the appropriate procedure and teach your children to do likewise. If you wish to question a decision you must go through your team manager.
5. Demonstrate respect for opposing players and their supporters.
6. Encourage and support demonstrations of honest effort, skilled performance and team play with generous applause.
7. Recognise the value and skill of volunteer coaches and officials. They give their time and resources to help create positive educational experiences for participants.

Please be aware that breaches of the above code may result in you being asked to leave an event.
